carboard to be posted in a flat envelope. The samples are shipped to Hipra's DIAGNOS laboratories where a PCR will be performed to see if *E.Coli* is naturally present there have the verotoxin virulent factor. (The bacteria is spread by feco-oral contact).

Altresyn® App by Ceva Animal Health

Ceva Animal Health has launched the Altresyn® app, a tool for helping farmers manage their gilt synchronisation. The app is available from both the App Store and Google Play Store. Users need to create an account with the farm details and can then use the De Luxe section to calculate the number of gilts to synchronise in each batch.

The app should be used to set up and track batches of gilts while on Altresyn® treatment. "Once the batches are created, a to-do-list' is generated by the app that shows the tasks for today and the coming days. This makes keeping track simple and the information can be viewed by multiple people on the farm on different mobile devices," the company said. Email batch information can be kept for farm records and future reference, while alarms can be set up as a reminder to give the treatment. Other app features include a trouble-shooter and gilt management pages.
